An example of this is the work being done between Nebraska VR, local businesses, area school systems, the Nebraska Commission for the Blind and Visually Impaired, Assistive Technology Partnership, and the Division of Developmental Disabilities. This partnership, known as Project SEARCH, includes a combination of classroom instruction, career exploration, and hands-on training through worksite rotations.

Project SEARCH allows youth who are transitioning from school to work to learn real-world job skills, giving them the opportunity for independence. It also helps businesses see what a great asset individuals with disabilities are in the workplace.
