## **Questions and Answers**

Question #1. Regarding cost proposals, should an applicant include federal in-kind or just state in-kind match sources, such as federal Medicaid Administrative Claiming (MAC) funds?

Answer #1. Applicants are welcome to document whatever additional funding they will have for the project however Nebraska VR is only allowed to report in-kind match from state sources to our TBI grant program, not in-kind match from federal sources.

Question #2. Are there character or word limits on the proposal narrative or any of the subsections?
